WHAT THIS RECORD DOES NOT CLAIM

No plate here alleges a crime by any named person. Where an individual is named it is because they were *targeted* by the material shown, and they are included with their consent. Several distinct organizations appear; shared slogans and imagery are shown where visible on the page, but no command structure or shared funding is asserted. Much of what is reproduced is protected expression; some of it is vandalism under Seattle ordinance. This document does not sort the two.

A NOTE ON THE PHOTOGRAPHS

Every plate is either material photographed by the compiler in public space in Seattle, or a capture of material the responsible organization published itself — each caption says which. Nothing is staged and no image is altered except for cropping and resizing. Where faces are blurred, the blurring is the publisher’s. Photographs were collected over 2025–2026; per-photograph dates were not recorded and are not reconstructed, so captions give the year range except where a date appears in the image itself.

SUMMARY OF OBSERVATIONS

Six things worth knowing

Every observation below is carried by plates in the section named.

01 Designated terrorist organizations are supported by name, in public.

A flyer at head height reads “ Hamas did NOTHING wrong.” At a June 2026 demonstration outside a Seattle World Cup match, the flags of **Hamas**, **Hezbollah** and the **PFLP** were flown together above the crowd — photographed and published by the organizers themselves. A separate poster carries “Death to America. Death to Zionism” over the flag of the Islamic Republic of Iran. — *Section I*

02 The October 7 attack is celebrated by name, on a banner, by a named local group.

At the same demonstration, Seattle Revolutionary Youth carried a banner reading “LONG LIVE OPERATION AL AQSA FLOOD!” signed with the organization’s name. A flyer elsewhere in the city advertises a “teach-in about October 7th” titled *The Right to Resist: Al-Aqsa Flood & Armed Resistance*. — *Section I*

03 Recruitment is organized, public, and reaches minors.

Seattle Revolutionary Youth tabled at the Capitol Hill Farmers Market with a sign-up sheet, selling Yahya Sinwar’s novel for \$40 beside an antisemitic conspiracy text. Its “Anti-Imperialist Summer Camp” drew, in the organizers’ words, “many youth, from high-schoolers to community college students,” to study doctrine from three foreign armed insurgencies. A soccer league in a city park is named *Fedayeen* — Arabic for armed guerrilla fighters — advertises with an illustration of a man holding a rifle, and welcomes “all ages.” — *Section II*

04 Denying opponents the ability to hold public events is a stated objective.

After a speaking event was shut down, an account promoting the action published: “*Zionists everywhere are going to learn: they can have no public events.*” Related material: flyers naming a speaker and his venue with a QR code for live location updates, a “Get to Know Your Local Zionist” sheet carrying a local attorney’s photograph and contact details, and pickets against two named small businesses. — *Section III*

05 The reach extends into the workplace — and into a national retailer’s outbound shipments.

A flyer from a group styling itself “Amazon Worker Intifada” was found inside a delivered Amazon package; its artwork includes a knife and a drone marked with the Star of David. The same group staged a banner beside the stage at a company concert on Amazon’s own campus and handed out flyers to an audience of interns. — *Section IV*

06 The messaging is frequently, and explicitly, about Jews — not only about Israel.

Handwriting on a public bollard reads “Fuck Jewish Nazis.” A poster shows a military boot crushing a Star of David above “CRUSH ZIONISM.” A flyer reads “Fuck Racist Jews Who Openly Celebrate Genocide.” A sticker renders a sitting Member of Congress as a skull inside a Star of David built from the American flag, captioned “Death PAC.” — *Sections III and V*

SECTION I

Open Support for Terror Groups

Designated organizations named, quoted, defended in print, and sold at a farmers market table for forty dollars.

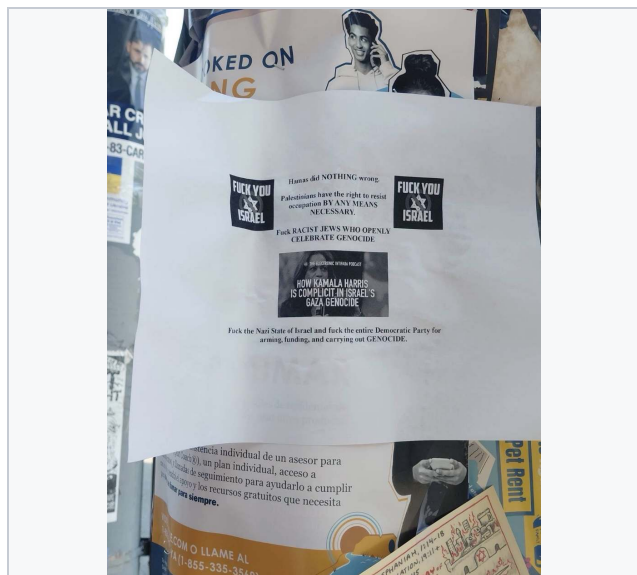

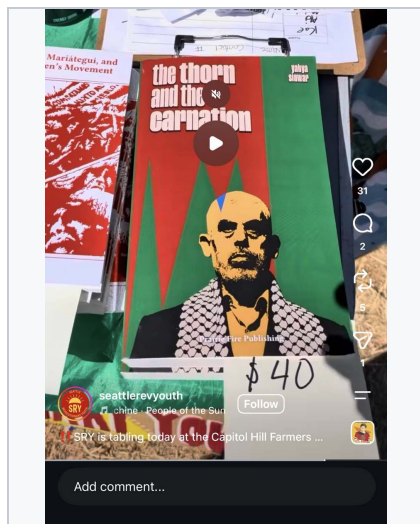

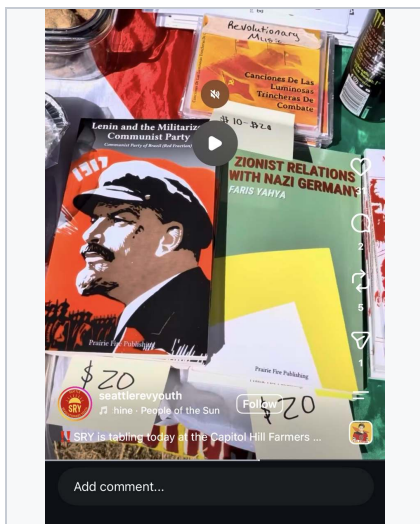

“Al-Aqsa Flood” is Hamas’s own operational name for the attack of October 7, 2023; using it adopts the attacker’s framing. The clipboard in Plate 3 carries printed columns for *Name* and *Contact #* — on a public street, at a Sunday family market.

1.2 The same commitments, photographed

Neither photograph is the compiler's. Both were taken by the organizers and published on their own website as the record of an action outside a Seattle World Cup match, June 26, 2026.

1.3 In the organizers' own words

Quoted verbatim from SERVETHEPEOPLE.NOBLOGS.ORG, which carries dispatches from Seattle Revolutionary Youth and the Anti-Imperialist League.

“The camp was attended by many youth, from high-schoolers to community college students, to young workers. The curriculum was based in documents from the Communist Party of Peru, Communist Party of Turkey/Marxist Leninist, and the Communist Party of India (Maoist).”

“Great importance was placed on supporting the Axis of Resistance in the Greater Middle East including Iran, the Palestinian Resistance, Hezbollah of Lebanon, and Ansarallah of Yemen.”

“Banners were hung in solidarity with the Communist Party of India (Maoist), and Axis of Resistance... With a red triangle over an Israeli occupation forces vehicle.”

“ANTI-IMPERIALIST SUMMER CAMP HELD IN PACIFIC NORTHWEST,” AUGUST 21, 2026

Hamas, Hezbollah and the Communist Party of Peru have been designated Foreign Terrorist Organizations since 1997; Ansarallah since March 2025. CPI (Maoist) and the CPT/ML are *not* U.S.-designated — they are designated by India and Turkey. The next article published on the same site is titled “*Learn From Hezbollah!*”

SECTION II

Recruitment, Including of Minors

A study camp for high-schoolers, and an all-ages sports league named for armed guerrillas.

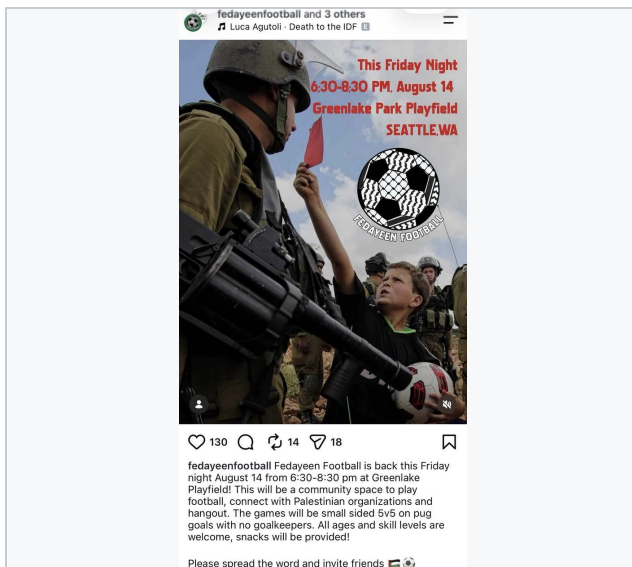

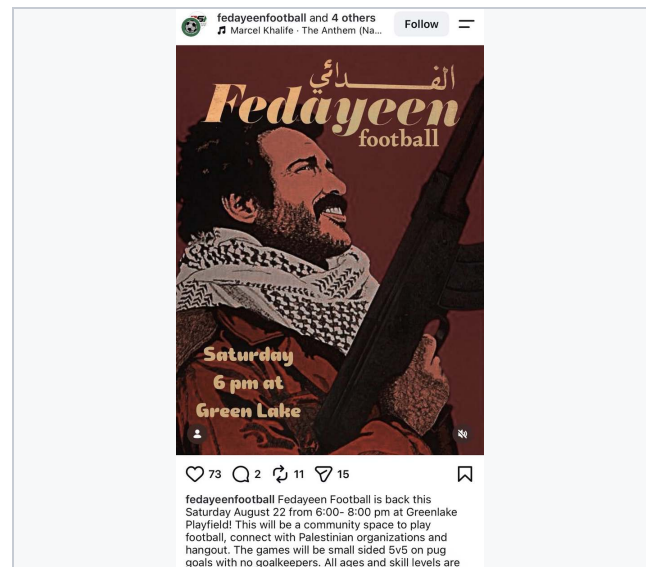

Green Lake Park is a Seattle Parks and Recreation facility; its playfield is used by youth leagues. An adult who spends a Friday evening under a banner naming armed guerrillas has made a political choice. A twelve-year-old brought to a free, all-ages, snacks-provided pick-up game has not.

SECTION III

Disruption of Events and People

The objective is not inferred from the conduct. It was published, in a sentence, by an account promoting it.

"Zionists everywhere are going to learn: they can have no public events."

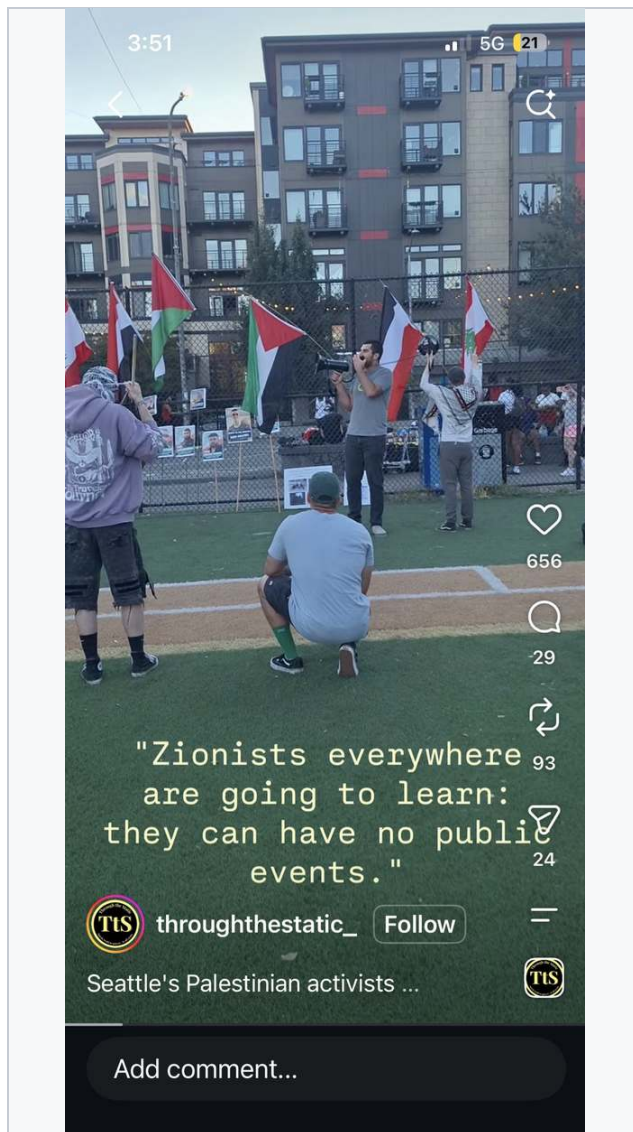


PLATE 12 Published after a Seattle speaking event was shut down. Self-published, @throughthetstatic_.

Not a complaint about one evening: a general denial of public assembly to a category of people, "everywhere." The flyer at right publishes a specific address and time at which a named individual will be present, and a QR code for redirecting a crowd if he moves.

3.2 Naming private individuals and businesses

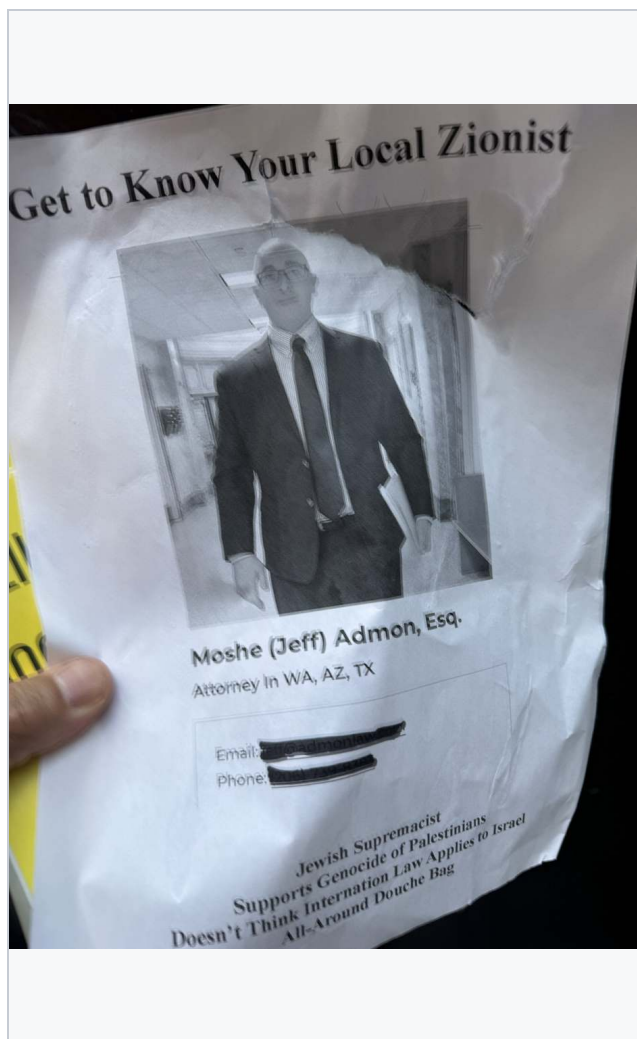

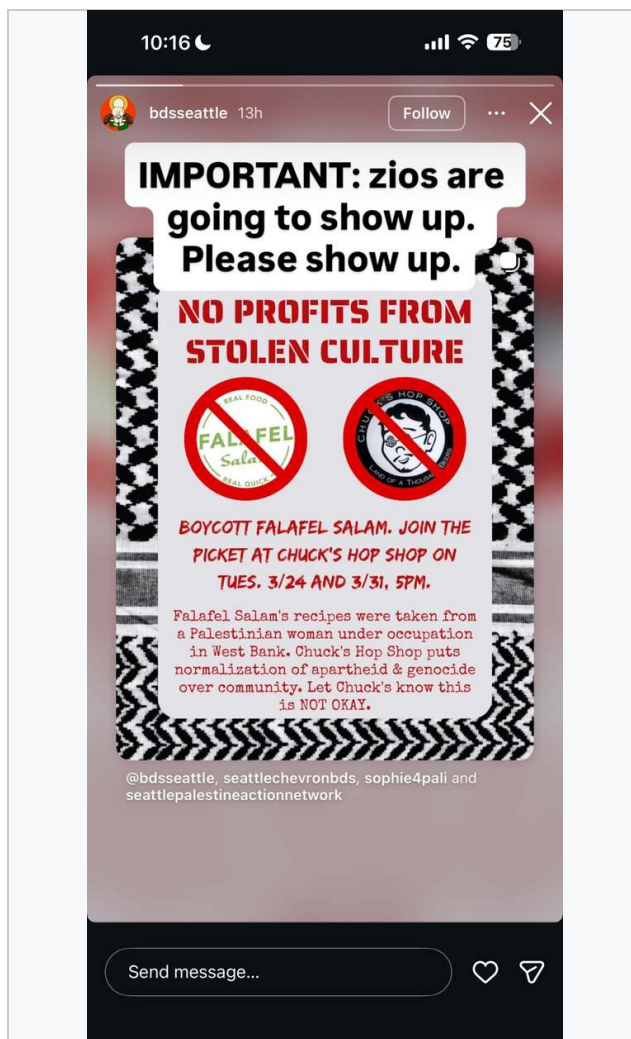

The flyer at left does not describe conduct. It describes an identity — “Jewish Supremacist” — and then publishes the means of contacting the person who holds it. Its headline is a template built for reuse.

At right, two named neighborhood businesses with picket dates, and supporters told in advance to expect counter-protesters. The stated grievance is not about Israel: it asserts that a restaurant’s recipes “were taken from a Palestinian woman under occupation in West Bank,” and that a taproom serving that food “puts normalization of apartheid & genocide over community.” The offense being punished is a menu.

3.3 Reported at a synagogue

Unlike the rest of this record, the items on this page and the next are neither the compiler's photographs nor the responsible organizations' own publications. They are accounts posted by other members of the public, reproduced as posted. The claims in them are the posters' own and are not independently verified here.

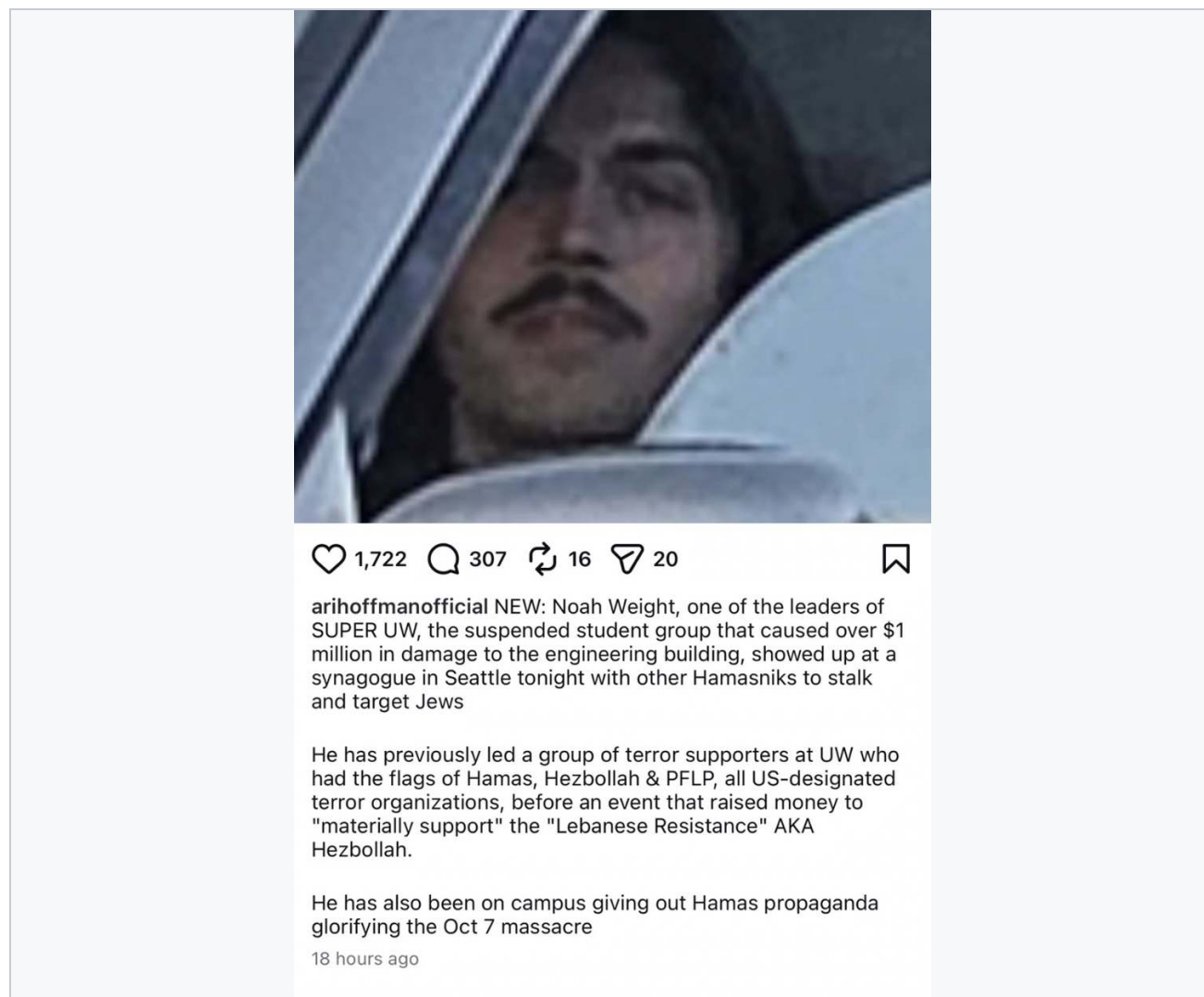


PLATE 16 A widely-circulated post naming **Noah Weight** as a leader of SUPER UW, the suspended University of Washington student group. It states that he “showed up at a synagogue in Seattle tonight with other Hamasniks to stalk and target Jews,” and that he had previously led a UW group displaying “the flags of Hamas, Hezbollah & PFLP... before an event that raised money to ‘materially support’ the ‘Lebanese Resistance’ AKA Hezbollah.” These are the poster’s claims; the compiler has not independently verified them and reproduces the post as published. *Self-published, @arihoffmanofficial, August 2026.*

This is the only place in the document where a private individual is named as a participant rather than as a target, and it rests on one person’s account. It is included for what it alleges — congregants approached outside a synagogue — and should be read as an allegation, not a finding.

3.4 Physical confrontation in public spaces

Three reported incidents in Seattle public spaces over four months of 2026: a City Hall hearing queue in August, a City Hall protest in May, and a public park in June. Two are first-person accounts by named individuals who published video of what they describe. Each poster identifies those involved as trans activists; those characterizations are theirs, reported here as made.

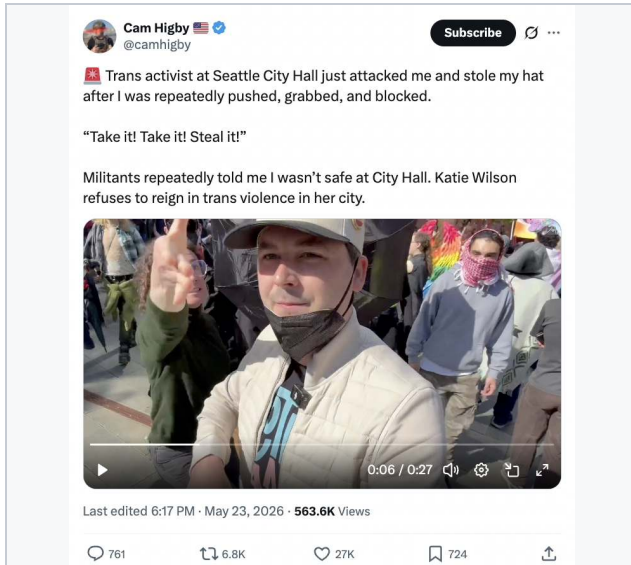


PLATE 17 Seattle City Hall, May 23, 2026. Journalist **Cam Higby**, posting video of the incident, states that he was “repeatedly pushed, grabbed, and blocked,” that his hat was taken — “Take it! Take it! Steal it!” — and that he was told he “wasn’t safe at City Hall.” The post has 563,000 views. He identifies those involved as trans activists; that characterization is his. *Self-published, @camhigby, May 23, 2026.*

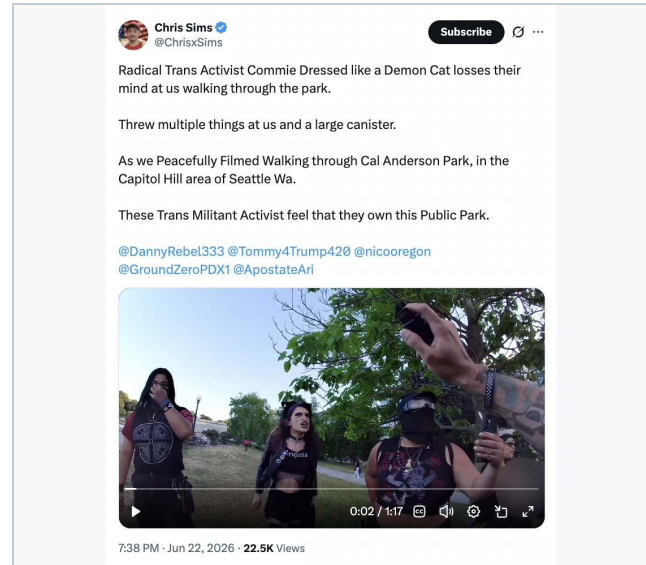

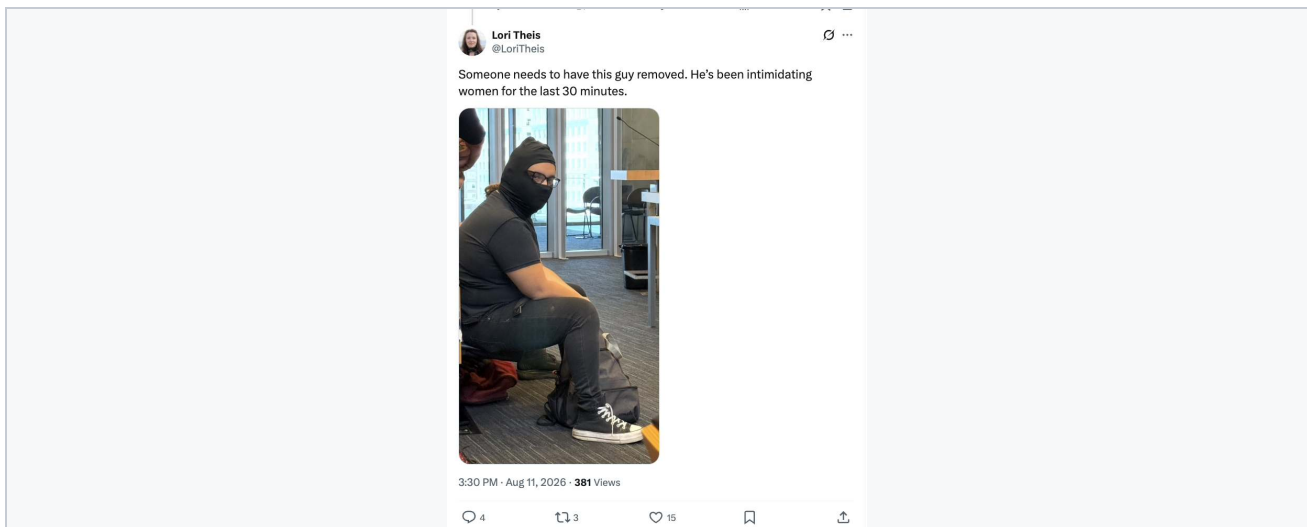

Taken together these describe conduct directed at people attending, filming, or queuing to testify at public proceedings and in public parks — the same category of interference documented earlier in this section against speakers, congregants and small businesses, arising from a different quarter.

3.5 A sitting Member of Congress

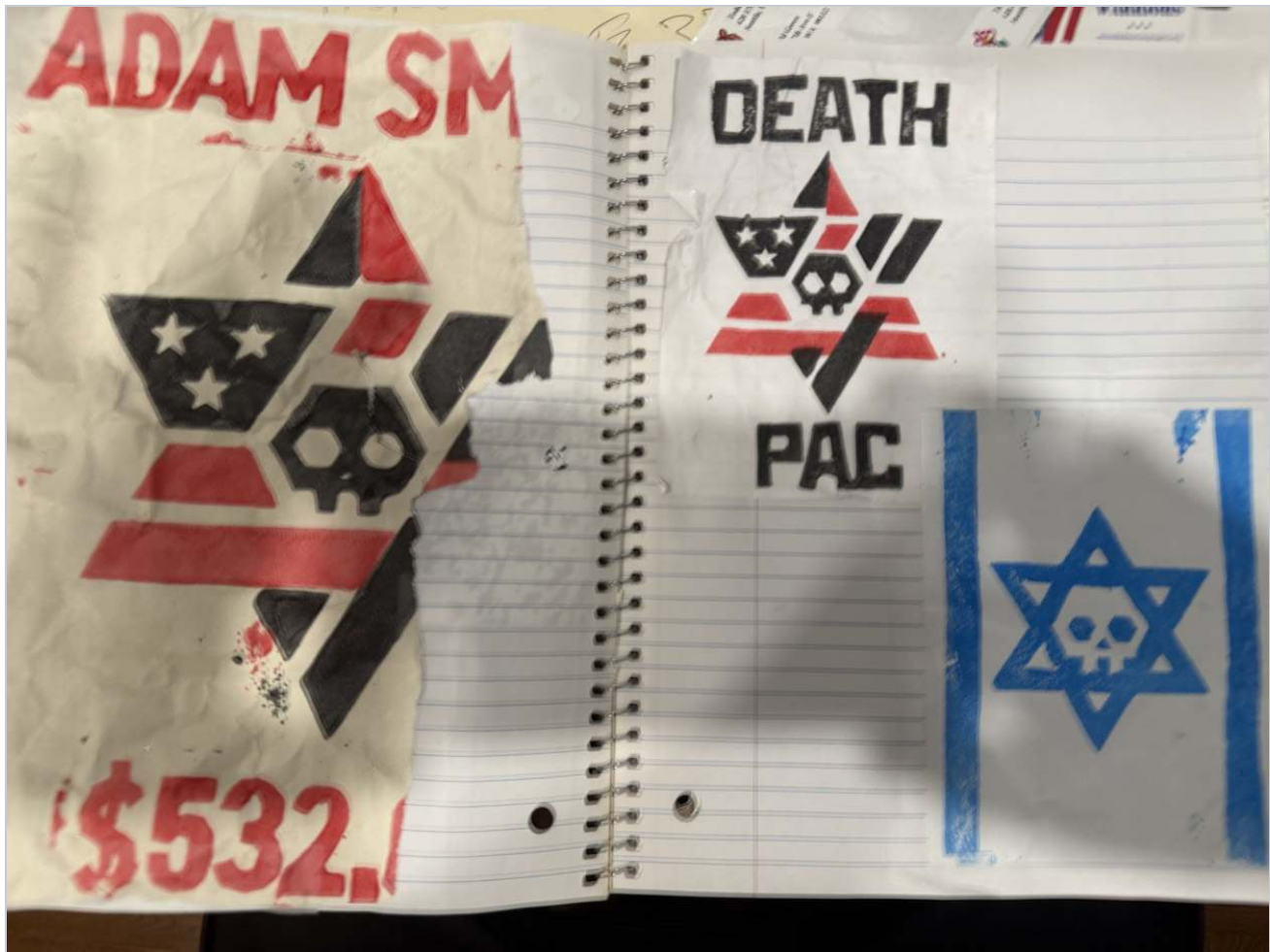

The compiler does not know who produced these, how widely they were posted, or whether any threat was intended, and claims none of those things. What the image establishes is narrower: a named Member of Congress rendered as a death’s head; an emblem fusing the American flag with the Star of David and a skull; multiple finished copies, hand-drawn and cut for application; produced by someone in his own state.

It sits at the end of a progression rather than apart from it. Shut down the event, publish the private individual’s photograph and contact details, name the businesses, name the Member. The organizing logic is the same throughout: identify a person, attach the label, publish the identification.

SECTION IV

Reach Into the Workplace: Amazon and Tech

A flyer inside a sealed customer order is not street expression. It is a national logistics network used as a delivery channel.

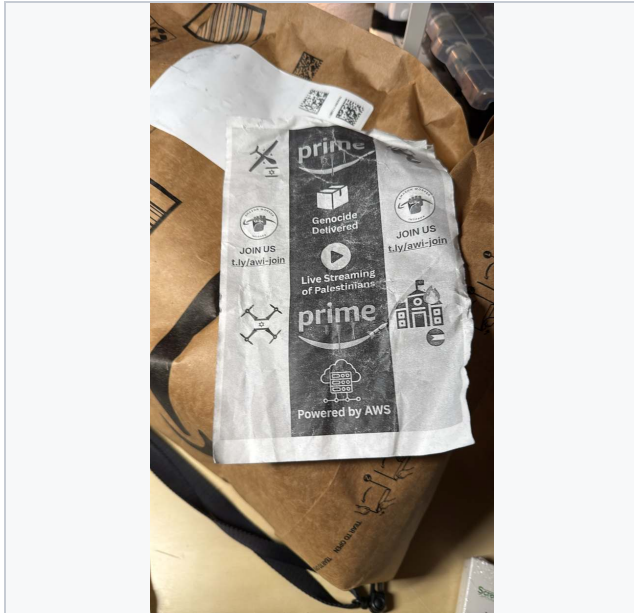

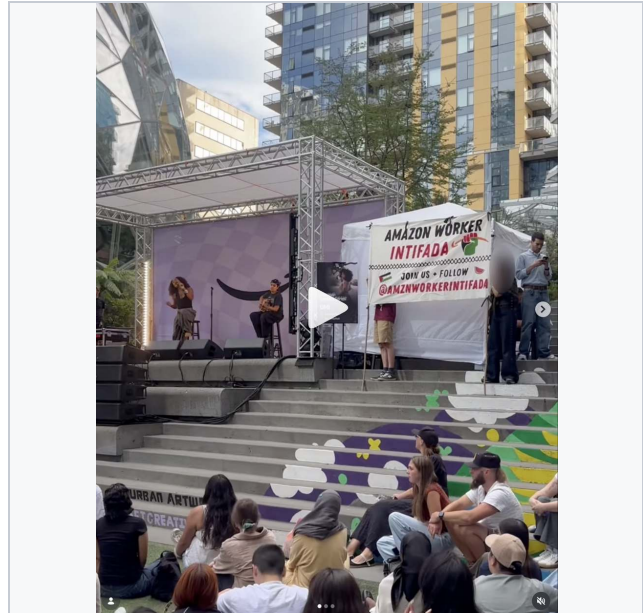

This record establishes one flyer in one package. It does **not** establish how many packages were affected, where in the chain the insertion occurred, or whether Amazon was aware. The mechanism is the point: a channel that bypasses the recipient’s choice and terminates in homes in every congressional district in the country.

SECTION V

Defaced Infrastructure

The standing environment a resident walks through, whether or not they went looking. Much of it is directed at a state and its army. A significant portion is not.

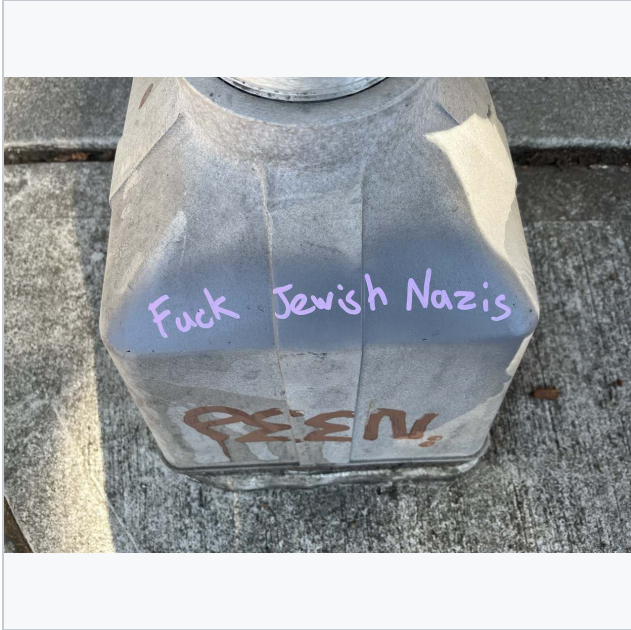


PLATE 24 Marker on a metal bollard at a sidewalk corner. *Seattle, 2025–2026.*

The accusation that Jews are the true Nazis recurs in every medium in this record: as a book for sale (Plate 4), as a sticker above, and painted at scale on the next page.

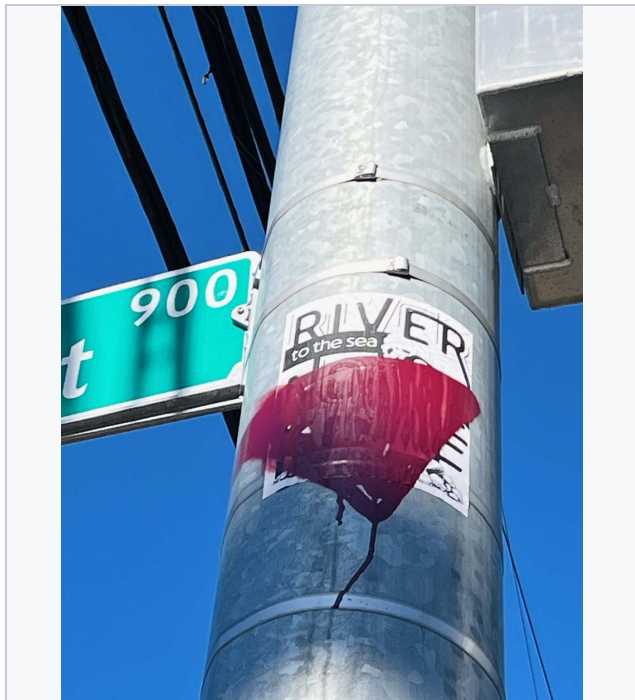

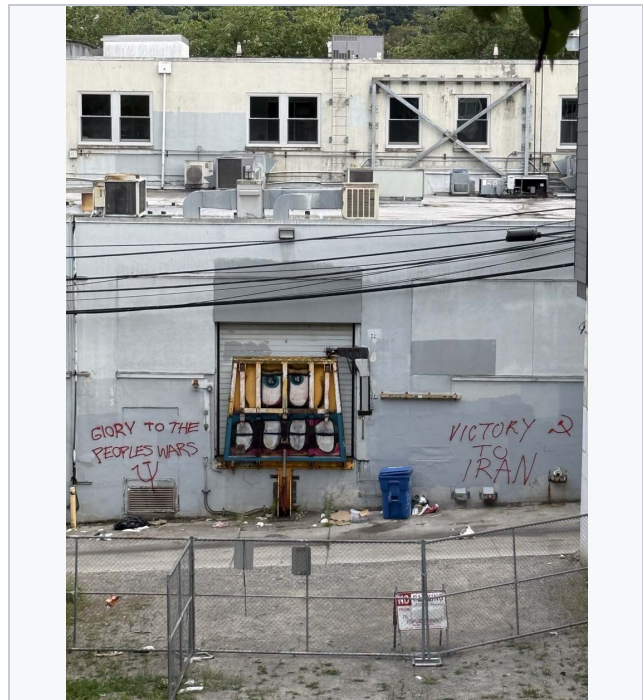

These are municipal and utility installations taken over in their entirety, in hand-painted work that took time to execute and has weathered in place. Plate 31 closes the loop Section I opened: “Glory to the People’s Wars” and “Victory to Iran” are the closing lines of the articles quoted on page 6. The website and the wall use the same script.

TERMS

Red inverted triangle ▼	Overlaid on targets in al-Qassam Brigades combat footage immediately before a strike. Sprayed, painted and used as flyer design throughout Section V; described in the organizers' own camp write-up as displayed on a banner "over an Israeli occupation forces vehicle."
Al-Aqsa Flood	<i>Tufan al-Aqsa</i> — Hamas's operational name for October 7, 2023. Used as a teach-in title and on the SRY banner.
Fedayeen	"Those who sacrifice themselves"; the Palestinian armed guerrilla groups of the 1960s–70s. Here, the name of an all-ages soccer league in a city park.
Axis of Resistance	The Iran-aligned bloc: Iran, Hezbollah, Hamas, Ansarallah, Iraqi militias. Named and endorsed in the organizers' published articles.

What this document is for

This record makes no request. It proposes no legislation and names no agency. It was assembled because the compiler lives in Seattle, watched this material accumulate over a year, and concluded that people who do not live there would not otherwise see it — and would not believe a description of it without the photographs.

Three of the threads do not stop at the city limits: a national retailer's outbound shipping used to place political material into a customer's home; a campaign built around a World Cup played across sixteen North American cities; and a sitting Member of Congress rendered as a skull by someone in his own state.

The only claim is the one on the cover: in one American city, this has become ordinary. It is on the poles, in the parks, at the market, and in the mail.
